DERBY CITY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS) (TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2023

WHEREAS DERBY CITY COUNCIL (hereinafter referred to as 'the Council') are satisfied that vehicular traffic in parts of the City of Derby should be restricted by reason of the 'Derby 10 Mile running event 2023'

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of their powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 as amended and of all other powers enabling them in that hereby make the following Order:-

1. On Sunday 19th November 2023, between the hours of 9:40am and 10:30am, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a vehicle involved in the Event or connected with the emergency services to proceed along

Royal Way 09:45 – 10:15,

Derwent Parade from Island 2 to Island 3 only 09:45 – 10:15,

Pride Parkway from Island 3 to Island 4 (eastbound closure) 09:45 – 10:15

Victoria Way 9:45 - 10:15

Royal Scot Road from Junction of Victoria Way to Island 4 only 09:45 – 10:15

Pride Parkway from Island 4 to the Junction with Pacific Way (southbound closure)

09:45 - 10:20

The Closure will be on a rolling basis with the roads re-opening after each point has been passed and it is safe to re-open them.

- 2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. This Order will come into operation on 17 August 2023 and may be cited as the Derby City Council (Various Roads) (Temporary Closure) Order 2023.
