THE SOUTH DERBYSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL (PREVENTION OF OBSTRUCTIONS TO VARIOUS STREETS IN THULSTON) ORDER 2024

MADE UNDER SECTION 21 OF THE TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847

WHEREAS between the hours of 9:30am and 11:40am on Sunday 17th November Two Thousand and Twenty-Four, certain streets will be thronged and liable to be obstructed, the SOUTH DERBYSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL pursuant to the powers conferred by Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, do HEREBY ORDER AND DIRECT that for the purpose of preventing obstruction in the said streets referred to below on the said days between the stated hours, the following regulations shall be observed:-

- 1. B5010 Shardlow Road from its junction with A6 Thulston Roundabout eastbound through to Thulston where it turns north bound on to Broad Lane B5010, then along Oak Road & Ball Lane B5010, Thulston to Main Road B5010, Elvaston Castle to a point approx. 810m north of Elvaston Castle on Station Road B5010 shall be closed to all vehicular traffic including motor and pedal cycles during the dates and times shown above.
- 2. There will a diversion in place for vehicles wishing to travel from West to East along the B5010 and northbound through Thulston and Elvaston. The route is from Thulston Island, A6, Raynesway, Nottingham Road, and B5010 Borrowash. There will also be a controlled safe access/egress to Grove Close, Silver Lane, Castle Court and Elvaston Castle.

The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Any person who offends against any of the provisions contained in this Order shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding One Thousand pounds.
